

Our November 2016 Prayer Letter

Dear Brethren,

Thank you for praying for Joanna. The lengthy infection she had is finally gone after another round of (different) antibiotics and she is thankful for that. The ENT wants her to return after the holidays so he can spray her tonsils and throat with something that's supposed to keep her from getting recurring infections. She is, however, battling multiple other symptoms and, so, would like to get some tests done at an allergy lab (the ENT "prescribed" that), a neurologist, and possibly one other specialist. It is encouraging to see her healthy. The boys have also gotten better and that's also a blessing. So, we've been reminded of late to be especially thankful for the health that we have.

The Lord opened doors to preach at a rehabilitation center. It's a Christian outfit that has several in Ukraine. Bro. Ed and I gave our testimonies and I gave a brief charge on "finishing the course" with one of Apostle Paul's missionary adventures. The director told me that he was thankful for the testimonies and word—that they were especially encouraging. A brother named Max, who has come a long way and has a strong desire to serve the Lord, has lately been under discouragement and has contemplated leaving. It was a charge for me to help that brother to see that the Lord is worth it. Before we left, the director prayed for our safe departure and arrival back to Kiev. About twenty minutes later, I was going through the intersection and couldn't fully turn. The tires on the van were bald in one area, so, with the snow and ice mix, I ran the van sideways in to the curb. I was not traveling very fast, but if a car had been there, we would've hit it for sure. We were all reassured of God's mercy and will to answer.

We have been working on getting some new tracts together for the church. We translated Brother Russel Wright's tracts that he made. (They've been translated into Ukrainian and Russian.) We are trying to put in an order for another missionary who's in Ukraine as well. These are real good tracts with pictures like in Chick tracts. We are praying that God will use these through the hands of the brethren here. We should have them delivered to us shortly, trying to get them before the New Year.

We are very thankful for your prayers and support and we pray for our brethren back home frequently. We are blessed to have such friends and brethren in the Lord. Our God keep you and shine his mercies upon you for his name sake. We are truly thankful for every prayer.
